Concerning the choice of **relative adverbs** or **pronouns**, the relative adverbs, "where", "when" and "why" can be used for *location*, *time*, and *the reason for something happening*, respectively. All can be replaced by "that" in defining relative clauses, but when "where" is replaced by "that" (or "which") an extra preposition must be added to the sentence. We use "which" for things, and in defining relative clauses "that" is also always possible. "Who", "whom" and "whose" are used for people.
